and receiving the recognition of being a "big leaguer", Nick Adenhardt's life was tragically taken, along with his friends 20-year-old Courtney Francis Stewart and 25-year-old Henry Pearson as a result of a drunk driving incident. The driver of the other vehicle, Thomas Gallo has been charged with three counts of murder.

Nick's success was hard earned and well deserved. Despite the obstacles he was forced to face including Tommy John ligament transplant surgery one week before the draft and right after being labeled Baseball America's high school player of the year in 2004, he fought hard to come back and indeed persevered with the help and support of family, friends, and

his extended family, the Anaheim Angels.

A cinderella story gone wrong, and three beautiful lives lost in such a senseless and horrific tragedy. Nick will never be gone. He will remain alive in the hearts and souls of those who were blessed enough to know him, and his presence in the world of baseball will forever be etched between the stadium walls of the Anaheim Angel's.

We wish to express our sincere sympathy to Nick's mom, Janet, father, Jim, step-father, Duane, and brother, Henry, as well as his extended family.
